



Checklist for an application for a licence to use the UPF Certification Trade Mark

• •

Current AS/NZS 4399 compliant test reports attached.

If you are submitting UPF reports generated by laboratories other than ARPANSA, you must attach a sample of the fabric of at least 200mm x 300mm (A4) in size. ARPANSA accepts test reports only from accredited laboratories. Check before submitting reports.

List of brand names, trademarks and labels completed.

• •

Descriptions of finished products completed, or attached (back of Schedule 3).

• •

Application form (Schedule 3) signed and dated.

• •

Cheque for licence fee enclosed.

Overview of the licensing procedure

- 1. The applicant sends the completed and signed licence application forms, licence fee and any other documentation required to ARPANSA.**
- 2. If ARPANSA approves the application, two blank licence agreements are prepared and returned to the applicant for signing. The applicant signs both copies of the licence agreement and returns them to ARPANSA.**
- 3. When ARPANSA receives the signed licence agreements it countersigns them, keeps one copy for its records and returns one copy to the applicant.**
