SITUATION

WA lost radioactive source (Caesium-137, 20 GBq), search and recovery operation. Further details provided in 20230130 1750 ANSTO SITREP WA source search.

Commonwealth support being provided by ANSTO, ARPANSA, and Defence.

OPERATIONS

ANSTO Field Assistance Team (FAT) deployed, comprising 7 ANSTO personnel, with return no later than Sunday 5 February. If mission continues further ANSTO support will require additional planning with consideration of impact to business and licence obligations.

All search teams have tested equipment and are now operational with confidence established in the working groups. Communication arrangements agreed.

Note: FAT designation adjusted to align with DFES allocations.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- DFES media photo shoot with equipment.
- Individual team objectives provided along with safety briefing and each team has an emergency service
 escort.
- Team Charlie and Team Delta, successful completion of first section in Perth. One observation of interest which was validated and determined to be nothing of concern.
- Team Beta on location in S22-Intelevant and surveys underway.
- Type A package departed ANSTO 31 January from Lucas Heights to travel overnight, arriving 1 February.

ACTIONS REQUIRED

Ops shall continue per the agreed plans for next 2 days.

FUTURE CONSIDERATIONS

- By Thursday 1600 AWST (1900 AEDT) multi-agency planning to have occurred on next steps, adjusting search parameters or ending mission. This could involve rotating ANSTO personnel for rest and recuperation.
- ANSTO Executive to review plan for extending or ending deployment of ANSTO Field Assistance Team by 1530 Friday 3 February.
