This form must be used for any activity that is potentially OHSE Category A. Activities which clearly involve only trivial hazards need not be formally categorised on this form. Normal office work is an example.

OHSE Category B Include with this document, justification that the activity, when implemented, will be adequately safe; and can be carried out in an adequately safe manner.
