- This Act may be cited as the Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety (Consequential Amendments) Act 1998.

2 Commencement

- (1) Subject to this section, this Act commences on the same day as the *Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Act 1998*.
 - (2) Item 5 of Schedule 1 to this Act commences on a day to be fixed by Proclamation.

3 Schedule(s)

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Subject to section 2, each Act that is specified in a Schedule to this Act is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this Act has effect according to its terms.

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6 T	ransfer of assets and liabilities of the Nuclear Safety Bureau
(1)	At the commencement time: (a) the assets and liabilities of the Nuclear Safety Bureau are transferred to the Commonwealth; and (b) the Commonwealth becomes the Nuclear Safety Bureau successor in law in relation to an asset or liability transfer under paragraph (a); and
(2)	Any instrument or document relating to a transferred asset or liabil continues to have effect after the commencement time as if a refere in the instrument or document to the Nuclear Safety Bureau were a reference to the Commonwealth.
(3)	In this item:
	 asset means: (a) any legal or equitable estate or interest in real or personal property, including a contingent or prospective one; or (b) any right, privilege or immunity, including a contingent prospective one.
	commencement time means the time at which section 1 of thi commenced.

7 P	owers of the CEO during the transition period
(1)	Despite the repeal of Part VIIA of the <i>Australian Nuclear Science of Technology Organisation Act 1987</i> by this Act, the CEO is to be treated, throughout the ANSTO transition period, as having all the powers and functions conferred by that Part on the Director of the Nuclear Safety Bureau in relation to ANSTO.
